

EUREKA CENTRE: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Eureka Centre is required to collect your first name and telephone number to help keep you, your family and our community safe from the spread of COVID-19 through early notification of possible exposure. Recording your attendance is one of the tools used to help protect the health of the community by quickly alerting people who may be at risk of having contact with the virus.

4. You may be declined entry to this facility, or requested to leave the facility, if you:
 - Are displaying potential COVID-19 symptoms (i.e. coughing, fever, runny nose);
 - Are not abiding by current public health directions with regard to: social distancing, hygiene practices, wearing of face masks
